

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- a) All families and students of such families who apply for admission are required to fully support the philosophy, objectives and policies of St. James & St. Ann's Catholic School.
- b) Application forms will be accepted without the Pastor's Authorization. Catholic students must have their Pastor's Authorization completed, signed and submitted at the time of the interview for admission.
- c) All school fees and any other money due for the present school year will have been paid according to the schedule.

Applications for re-registration will not be accepted for those who are in arrears until obligations have been met.

ADMISSION PRIORITY:

Students will be admitted to this school in the following priority sequence, to the maximum enrollment for each grade as determined by the Regional Education Committee and the pastors.

- Priority 1:** Students currently enrolled in the school if they and their families meet the expectations of the school.

- Priority 2:** Siblings of children already in the school, whose families are practicing Catholics active in one of the four regional supporting parishes of the School (St. James, St. Ann's, Sts. Joachim and Ann, and St. Joseph's, Mission).

- Priority 3:** Children whose families are practicing Catholics active in one of the four regional supporting parishes on a first come, first served basis.

- Priority 4:** Siblings of children already in the school, whose families are practicing Catholics active in a parish, outside of one of the four regional supporting parishes of the School.

- Priority 5:** Children whose families are practicing Catholics active in a parish, outside of one of the four regional supporting parishes of the School.

- Priority 6:** Children whose families are either not practicing Catholics or who are not active in their parish.

*** Pastor's Authorization is required of the above.**

- Priority 7:** All other students regardless of religious denomination, with or without Pastor's Authorization for admission. Siblings of non-Catholic students cannot be given priority over Catholic students.

STUDENTS WITH EXCEPTIONALITIES: St. James & St. Ann's Catholic School is committed to providing a Catholic education to all students in the Fraser Valley. Parents of children with exceptionalities should contact the principal to ensure that the appropriate program can be put in place for their child.
